Application for Visa Extension

The process of the application for Visa Extension (Non-Immigrant "ED"):

- Two weeks before visa expires, international students do need to contact the International Relations and Communications Office (IRCO) with your original passports and to get the letter from IRCO on the appointment date.
- International students go to the Immigration Bureau, Government Complex Commemorating His Majesty the King, Chaengwattana Rd.
 - 3. Required Documents for Visa Extension.
 - 3.1) The official letter issued by the university.
- 3.2) An original copy of receipt of tuition fees or a current exchange transcript of Academic Record.
 - 3.3) An application form (TM.7)
 - 3.4) A copy of passport
 - 3.5) 1 passport photo (4x6 cm.)
 - 3.6) 1,900 Baht fee for a single-entry visa
 - 3.7) 3,800 Baht fee for a multiple-entry visa

Notes If your visa expires, you will be fined 500 baht per day, up to a maximum fine of 20,000 baht.
